

LL 2228 PICKETERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Behave on the picket line. You are representing the entire organization when you are serving picket duty. Obey traffic signals and stay out of the road.
2. Please don't abuse the vehicles going in and out of the plant.
3. Talk positive to the press – let them know why we are on strike (use the handbill – to see the line of the day if you are stuck for ideas)
4. Be very, very careful about identifying anyone as a scab. It's too easy to make a mistake, and the last thing we ever want to do is to falsely brand a Union Brother or Sister with that awful label. Think for a second how horrible you would feel. So please exercise extreme caution in making scab reports, make sure you have accurately identified the person. Don't report someone because you see a car that looks like their car.
5. Don't drink alcohol or use drugs on the picket line.
6. Be sure to take copies of the handbills and flyers. Also place one of the car window signs in your car to let the community know you are one of the striking Machinists. It will help raise visibility away from the plant.
7. Listen to your Picket Captain and be sure picket duty card is signed off.
8. If you have some spare time, feel free to volunteer at the strike headquarters – we can always use more people.
9. If you have any food or water you would like to donate, please bring it to any of the the picket gates or the strike headquarters
10. Help each other to stay strong – together we will win this battle!!!!
